SUBJECT: Local Rule Update / Change - Short Turn Placement

Commencing with Crew Change Sunday, November 13th the following Local rule update / change regarding short turn placement will be in effect.

Engineers:

Current local rule:

4 (g) Spare board locomotive engineers called in short turn service making 100 chargeable miles or less may retain their original position, respective of other engineers remaining first. (revised April 2004)

Revision:

4(g) Spare board Engineers called in any service and earning 125 chargeable miles or less may remain first out respective of other Spare Engineers remaining first out.

Conductors:

Short Turn for Coquitlam Conductor Freight Pool and Coquitlam Trainman Spareboard:

- a) Coquitlam Freight Pool Conductors working in other than Straightaway Service may remain first out respective of other C/T remaining first out at the home terminal and the away from home terminal. (Note: Work trains are called in either Straightaway or Turn service, as per the Collective Agreement).
- b) Spareboard Trainpersons called in any service and earning 125 chargeable miles or less may remain first out respective of other Spare Trainpersons remaining first out.
- c) When repositioning first out under this rule, Conductors or Spare Trainpersons will be repositioned to their previous switch time.
- d) When repositioning first out at the Home Terminal under this rule, Conductors or Spare Trainpersons MUST book a minimum of 3 hours rest. Must reposition at time of tie-up.
- e) The company will not be responsible for any additional costs that may relate to the misuse and/or application of these rules by Conductors/Trainpersons.

- f) Any Conductor/Trainperson found to be abusing the application of these rules will have their right to the application of these rules removed for a period of 6 months.
- g) May only reposition after first short turn. After working two consecutive short turns, must be placed at the bottom of Pool/Spareboard.
